






Morrison Headwaters "qax mot"

- JURISDICTION: Village of Cumberland and Electoral Area C of the Comox Valley Regional District.
 K'omoks First Nation territory.
- OWNER: Comox Timber (Manulife Investment Management)
- LAND USE: Private Managed Forest Land Reserve.
- ZONING: Heavy Industry (I-4).


