



## How we're structured





## How we're structured



**Independent regional boards:** provide oversight to the planning and implementation of the FWCP and are responsible for approving all FWCP projects and budgets.

**Steering committee:** sets the policy direction for the FWCP including governance and the strategic framework.

**First Nations Working Group:** provides advice and ensures First Nations' considerations and input are included in strategic planning, annual operating plans and projects.

**Fish and Wildlife Technical Committees:** provide technical advice to the regional Boards and regional managers related to strategic planning, and project selection.

**Region managers:** report to their boards and are responsible for overall for program implementation, including Board and committee coordination, budget and contract development and management, proponent liaison and strategic planning.

**The program manager** supports operational and strategic planning and activities for each region and is responsible for communicating FWCP information to the policy committee and between regional Boards.
