Do you want to make a difference to help fish and wildlife in the Columbia Region? Then here's your chance! We're looking for a new public representative to join our Columbia Region Board who can bring a regional perspective, represent a broad range of public interests, and make a three-year commitment.

As a member of our Board you will review and approve proposed fish and wildlife projects, and join other Board members in guiding the work of the Fish & Wildlife Compensation Program (FWCP) in our Columbia Region.

The Board's primary responsibility is making the funding decisions and determining fish and wildlife priorities for the FWCP in this area. The 10-person Board is made up of three public representatives, three First Nations, and two each from BC Hydro and the Province of B.C.
